WHAT DOES NET PAY ADVANCE DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect, and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social security number and income
- Account balances and payment history
- Transaction history and overdraft history

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to operate their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Net Pay Advance chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Net Pay Advance does not share with our affiliates	
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Net Pay Advance, Inc. NPATX, LLC NPAKS, LLC NPAMO, LLC NPAUT, LLC NPATN, LLC NPATN, LLC NPASC, LLC NPASC, LLC
